GUIDELINE

1:00 **Purpose:**

- 1:01 The purpose of the Buddy System is to ensure that if one fire fighter becomes injured, trapped or unconscious, the buddy will be available to assist or call for help.
- 2:00 **Procedures:**
- 2:01 A team of firefighters (minimum of 2) entering a hazardous area must us the buddy system of entering, working and exiting as a team
- 2:02 No one exits a hazardous area alone, If a situation makes it necessary for one member of the team to exit, such as a malfunctioning SCBA, the team members exit in pairs or the entire team exits.
