GUIDELINE

1:00 **Purpose:**

1:01 To ensure the safety of all personnel by only performing high-angle rescues based on the limitations of our training.

2:00 **Procedures:**

- 2:01 High-Angle rescues to high structures, high rise buildings, confined space and rough terrain will be limited to the use of ground ladders and aerials. Ropes **shall not** be used to raise or lower personnel to gain access to and egress from the rescue location. On rough terrain rescues (low grade slopes only-15 to 35 degrees), a rope may be used to support personnel, victims and the rescue stretcher.
- 3:00 **Scope:**
- 3:01 It shall be the responsibility of the Captain/ Officer in charge of each shift to ensure that this guideline is explained and followed
- 3:02 It shall be the responsibility of <u>all employees</u> to understand and adhere to this guideline.
