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GUIDELINE

1:00 **Purpose:**

- 1:01 To ensure that Fire Apparatus over 4500 KG be inspected on an annual basis as per MTO Regulation 611.
- 2:00 **Procedures:**
- 2:01 The employer shall schedule annual Fire Apparatus Inspections as per MTO Regulation 611 and ensure the displayed inspection sticker is compliant.
- 2:02 Drivers shall conduct a pre-trip circle check daily at the start of their shift or as soon as possible when time permits.
- 2:03 Every Monday drivers shall conduct a weekly inspection of all fire apparatus using the Apparatus Inspection Log Book.
- 2:04 The first Monday of each month the driver shall conduct a monthly inspection of all fire apparatus using the Apparatus Inspection Log Book.

THIS GUIDELINE IS NOT EXPECTED TO SUBSTITUTE FOR GOOD JUDGEMENT AND EXPERIENCE UNDER UNUSUAL CONDITIONS.

3:01	It shall be the responsibility of the Captain/ Officer in charge of each shift to ensure that this guideline is explained and followed.
3:02	It shall be the responsibility of <u>all employees</u> to understand and adhere to this guideline.
